Information for parents - please read very carefully, new important information.

NOTE NEW RACE LOCATION: Knockaloe Beg Farm, Patrick.

Children will be racing boys against boys, girls against girls, although some races will be combined. They will be racing in school year groups. The races take place around the **Knockaloe Beg Farm** area, with the longer race reaching Corrin's Folly.

TRAVEL: There will be a one way system in place as the access road is very narrow. You will **not be able to leave the site** until registration is closed and racing starts. If you are being dropped off, you will need to walk to the farm from Patrick Road (750m). **The supervision of children is the responsibility of parents/guardians.** Once registration is closed and racing starts at **1:30pm**, the access road will be reversed. **Late comers will not be allowed to race.** Spectators arriving after registration closes will have to park on Patrick Road and walk to the farm. Once the consent form is completed and returned to school, your child has to arrive at the race area to collect their number. There will be a wait before their race starts, please ensure they wear suitable clothing to keep warm and dry before and after the race. The cafe will be open with hot and cold drinks and cakes available - please supervise children in this area. There will be access to toilets. Children not racing and spectators will need to keep clear of the race areas. Marshals will be on hand to direct spectators. Children are briefed before they race. Where numbers allow, boys and girls will race in separate races. Each race gets longer and involves more hills as the children get older. Year two race over a short, off road course, year six and seven will race up as far as Corrin's Folly. Race routes on the MFR website: (manxfellrunners.org). It may be worth a visit to the area before the race date, but please avoid fields with livestock. They will be removed on race day. **Livestock:** Animal faeces will be on the ground where children are racing. Please ensure hand washing is carried out as necessary. Please be aware that **ticks** may also be in the area. Please check for ticks after the event and remove appropriately.

Year 2 race starts at 13:30 and in year order thereafter.

Number collection times: Registration is open for ALL racers from 12:00 until 1:00pm.
